**Minutes of the meeting held in the Office of Secretary (Sports), Room No.3, C-Wing, Gate No.6, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi, on 6<sup>th</sup> January, 2017 at 15.30 Hrs. to discuss the modalities of holding the National Level Sports Competitions under Khel India in New Delhi.**

Secretary (Sports) chaired the meeting.

2. List of participants is annexed.
3. At the outset, Secretary (Sports) welcomed the participants. JS (Development) informed the participants that the National Level Sports Competitions under Khelo India are being held in New Delhi. The competitions will be held for Cycling on 15<sup>th</sup> January, 2017 at Indira Gandhi Sports Complex (IGSC), Swimming on 15<sup>th</sup> January, 2017 at Dr. SPM Swimming Pool Complex and Wrestling on 20<sup>th</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup> January, 2017 at Indira Gandhi Sports Complex. He explained that while participants from all States/UTs are expected to participate in the competitions, it would be desirable to invite school children from schools in Delhi NCR so as to enhance their exposure to sports and also encourage the participants performing before a full house.
4. Secretary (Sports) added that the venues where the competitions are being held are state-of-the art, world class facilities and exposure to such ambience, with sportspersons from all over the country in the fray, would certainly encourage not only children inclined towards sports but can also kindle the curiosity and enthusiasm of relatively non-inclined children and may inspire them to take up sports as a career option. He, therefore, urged representatives from the Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS), the New Delhi Municipal Corporation (NDMC) and the Government of National Capital Territory (NCT) of Delhi to encourage maximum children to watch the events. He also emphasized on the need of putting into place a permanent mechanism to invite school children from schools in Delhi NCR for all National and International events being held in the SAI Stadia in Delhi so as to inculcate sporting culture among them. He advised KVS, NDMC and Government of NCT of Delhi to project the number of potential attendees ahead of every such event so that sufficient number of seats could be blocked for them.
5. Secretary (Sports) informed all present that the Government is planning to implement a National Physical Fitness Programme (NPFP) to develop age-category based fitness standards for the entire nation, and that the tests to be conducted under the programme would be simple tests that could be conducted by non-experts, including teachers in schools. He exhorted the KVS, being one of the strongest education systems in the country, to make all efforts to set up a model system of holistic education incorporating sports as an essential component of the same. He observed that the KVS, with a pan-India presence, 1200 odd schools and about 12 lakh student base, is a perfect candidate for running a pilot programme of the NPFP. He felt that the Lakshmi Bai National Institute of Physical Education (LNIPE) could run a pilot programme with the KVS in a few of its schools in Gwalior which could be scaled up and emulated in other schools. He felt that the programme could also be run in the Navodaya Vidyalaya Sangathan (NVS).

6. This was followed by deliberations on holding of the National Level Sports Competitions under the Khelo India in Delhi, and engagement of schoolchildren in Delhi NCR on a sustained basis, based on which the following decisions were taken/ points agreed to :

5.	Promotion of excellence among the school children of KVS, NVS, NDMC, and Govt. of NCT of Delhi.	KVS has the largest pool of children under one umbrella, in the country. Therefore, tapping into this potential talent pool can yield rich dividends for the country, so far as sports is concerned. KVS may, therefore, in collaboration with the Department of Sports, chalk out and implement a plan for identification and grooming of sporting talent from amongst its student base with a view to produce Olympians.
