Sub: Elections of office bearers of All India Tennis Association – reg.

Elections of All India Tennis Association (AITA) for the term 2016-2020 were held on 3rd September, 2016 at Indore wherein following office bearers were elected:-

President : Shri Anil Khanna
Secretary General : Shri Hironmoy Chatterjee
Treasurer : Shri Raktim Saikia

2. Shri Anil Khanna who was nominated as President did not accept the position as the Ministry had previously asked AITA to advise Mr. Khanna to step down as President of AITA in accordance with the age and tenure clause of Sports Code.

3. Thereafter, on the directions of MYAS, AITA conducted Special General Meeting on 03.02.2017 at Pune and conducted the election for the post of President of AITA. Shri Surinder Goel, advocate conducted the elections as Returning Officer. Shri Rajiv Sarin, Deputy Director, Sports Authority of India was present as Government observer.

4. The documents pertaining to both the elections have been examined in the Ministry and after taking into account the provisions of the National Sports Development Code of India, 2011 (NSDCI), it has been noticed that the provisions of the NSDCI have been adhered to. Hence, it has been decided to accept the results of both the elections and the following set of office bearers of AITA for the period 2016-2020 has been taken on the records of the Ministry:-


