Subject: Notice Inviting Tender (NIT) for selection of Knowledge Partner for National Sports Talent Search Scheme (NSTSS) under Department of Sports.

Reference NIT No. 12-1/MYAS/RGKA/2015 dated 24th July, 2015, 11th August, 2015 and 14th August, 2015 on the above mentioned subject.

2. The clarification on various points raised by prospective bidders and those discussed in the Pre-Bid meeting held on 06th August, 2015 and on 19th August, 2015 is issued as follows:-

S. No.	Clause No.	Clarification
1.	1.2	The word "Knowledge Partner" may be substituted by "Knowledge-cum-Service Delivery Partner". The word "Knowledge Partner", wherever occurring in the NIT may be substituted by "Knowledge-cum-Service Delivery Partner".
2.	2.2.1	The battery of tests shall be conducted by the respective States/Schools. The tests shall be conducted for the children in the age group of 8-12 years. Fee @ Rs. 500/- per school per annum in case of Govt. Schools and @ Rs. 1000/- in the case of Govt. aided/private schools will be collected by the prospective "Knowledge-cum-Service Delivery Partner".
3.	2.2.2	The NSTSS Web Portal shall be developed by the prospective "Knowledge-cum-Service Delivery Partner". The web portal shall be GIGW certified from STQC and security audited for "Safe to Host" Certification from CERT-in/CERT-in empanelled vendors before deployment at Data Centre of Government of India. The "Knowledge-cum-Service Delivery Partner" shall visit each school and collect the hard copy of the data generated duly authenticated by the physical education teacher as well as Principal/Head of the School. The data collected after conducting the battery of tests shall be fed, stored and maintained in the NSTSS Web Portal so developed in such a way that the stored data could be retrieved as and when required by MYAS. Only one bidder will be selected to do this job on an all India basis. However, consortium comprising not more than five partners, will be allowed. In case of consortium approach, all the consortium partners shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire assignment. However, one of the consortium partners must become the lead member of the consortium and the MYAS shall deal only with the lead member for all the purposes. The lead member of such consortium shall be responsible for any act of omission or commission on the part of any of the consortium partners. The sentence "Primarily, the State/UT government machinery will be utilized in this mammoth exercise spread over the country in a period of 2 months per annum" is amended as "Primarily, the State/UT government machinery will be utilized in this mammoth exercise spread over the country."

4.	2.2.3.5	Deleted.
5.	2.2.3.11	The battery of tests as laid down as part of NSTSS scheme shall be followed by the States/Schools without any modification/change etc. However, the “Knowledge-cum-Service Delivery Partner” may suggest any modification for the approval of MYAS before implementation.
6.	2.2.3.17	The Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) over the NSTSS web portal, data generated and all intellectual properties related thereto will lie with the Department of Sports, MYAS.
7.	2.2.3.18, 2.2.3.19 and 2.2.3.20	These clauses pertain to 2 nd phase which may be ignored now. The NIT is meant for the first phase only.
8.	2.2.4	Revenue sharing will be on the pre-decided pattern of 50:50 for all revenues earned by the “Knowledge-cum-Service Delivery Partner” on only permissible items of advertisement as decided by the Government.
9.	9.1	Revised as follows:- Two Bid system: The offer shall be submitted in 2 separate sealed covers – one for Technical Bid and the other for Financial Bid. The Technical Proposal shall be placed in a sealed cover clearly marked as “ Technical Bid in response to Department of Sports NIT No. 12-1/MYAS/RGKA/2015 dated 24th July, 2015 for selection of “Knowledge-cum-Service Delivery Partner” for NSTSS under Department of Sports ”. Similarly, the financial proposal shall be placed in a sealed cover clearly marked as “ Financial Bid in response to Department of Sports NIT No. 12-1/MYAS/RGKA/2015 dated 24th July, 2015 for selection of “Knowledge-cum-Service Delivery Partner” for NSTSS under Department of Sports ” and will also mention the name of the Bidder with address and Stamp. The envelopes containing the Technical Bid alongwith EMD and bid processing fees and Financial Bid shall be placed in an outer envelope and sealed. The outer envelope containing the “Technical Bids” and “Financial Bid” shall be clearly marked as “ Bids in response to Department of Sports NIT No. 12-1/MYAS/RGKA/2015 dated 24th July, 2015 for selection of “Knowledge-cum-Service Delivery Partner” for NSTSS under Department of Sports ”. This outer envelope shall bear the address of the recipient as mentioned in Para 9.6 below and will also mention the name of the Bidder with address and Stamp. The Department of Sports, MYAS shall not be responsible for misplacement, loss or premature opening if the outer envelope is not sealed and / or not marked as stipulated. The validity of the bids submitted should be for a period of 6 months.
10.	9.4	The sentence “All taxes, levies etc, as applicable should be mentioned separately” is deleted.



11.	Annexure 2, S. No. 5	The "Knowledge-cum-Service Delivery Partner" shall visit each school and collect the hard copy of the data generated duly authenticated by the physical education teacher as well as Principal/Head of the School. However, if he so desires and finds feasible, the relevant data could also be collected in real time through hand held or any other electronic devices.
12.	Annexure 5	Deleted.
13.	Annexure 10 Contract Clause 8	"All payments" means all payments due to the "Knowledge-cum-Service Delivery Partner".
14.	Annexure 10 Contract Clause 9 (d)	Reasonable opportunity of hearing as per the principle of natural justice shall be provided as per law of the land. This is clarified under Clause 9.1.2.
15.	Annexure 10 Contract Clause 9 (f)	"Quality services" means services which yield the desired output.
16.	Annexure 10 Contract Clause 9 (h)	As clarified under Clause 9.1.2, there is no Unilateral Termination.
17.	Annexure 10 Contract Clause 9.5	"Satisfactorily Performed" means services performed which yield the desired output.
18.	Annexure 10 Contract Clause 10.3	Prior written consent of MYAS is required to share any information with any person or entity.
19.	Annexure 10 Contract Clause 10.4	The terms & conditions will be decided with mutual consent.
20.	Annexure 10 Contract Clause 10.5	The details of inspection and audit shall be decided by the Statutory Auditing Authority.

21.	Annexure 10 Contract Clause 11.2	“Personnel” means all personnel mentioned in Annexure – 5.
22.	Annexure 10 Contract Clause 13	The successful bidder will be paid 10% of monthly retainer fee as advance. After completion of development of NSTSS Web Portal, its testing and deployment, an amount equal to 3 months monthly retainer fee will be paid. To ensure capture and analysis of data evenly throughout the year, the successful Bidder is required to collect data from atleast a minimum of 3000 schools per month. The first input from the successful bidder is expected after 4 months from the date of issue of work order. The monthly retainer fee will be paid after submission of the data in respect of a minimum of 3000 schools for the month concerned. However, upto a maximum of 10% of monthly deficit may be allowed to be carried forward to the next month.

4. Since Annexure 5 stands deleted vide S. No. 12 of Para 2 above, Information vide Clause 9.2 (v) of the NIT (Technical Bid) will be in Annexure 4 (modified), Annexure 6 and Annexure 7 (modified). The Financial Bid, vide Clause 9.4 of the NIT will be in Annexure 8 (modified).

5. The last date for submission of bids is upto 1500 Hrs., on 31st August, 2015. The bids will be opened at 1530 Hrs., on 31st August, 2015.
