ORDER

Sub: Elections of Indian Kayaking & Canoeing Association held on 13th April, 2018 – reg.

Indian Kayaking & Canoeing Association (IKCA) is granted recognition by this Ministry as a National Sports Federation for promotion and regulation of Kayaking & Canoe Sport in the country. Elections of IKCA were due in April, 2018.

2. Accordingly IKCA informed the Ministry that it will conduct elections for its governing body for the term 2018-2022 on 13th April, 2018 at Bhopal. Elections were held under the supervision of Dr. P.S.Chauhan, Ex-Principal Secretary, Department of Law, Govt. Of Madhya Pradesh as Returning Officer. Ministry deputed Shri Rajinder Singh, Director In-charge, Central Regional Centre, Sports Authority of India as Government observer for the said elections of IKCA.

3. Report of Returning Officer and Government Observer along with other relevant documents received in the Ministry have been examined in light of the provisions of the National Sports Development Code of India, 2011 and it has been decided to accept the elections of IKCA held on 13th April, 2018 and following office bearers have been taken on records of the Ministry for the period 2018-2022:-

4. However, it is further informed that elections of Mr. K. Jayabalan has not been accepted in light of this Ministry's order No.9-38/2016-SP-I dated 14.02.2017 (copy enclosed) as he is a PSU employee and has already been Joint Secretary since 2010. Therefore, IKCA shall ask Mr. K. Jayabalan to step down.

5. Further, for the posts which have been vacated after few persons stepped down from such posts on being elected to two posts, IKCA may fill these vacant post as per the provisions of the Sports Code, if it so desires.


Subject: Instructions regarding holding of elective posts in sports bodies by employees of Public Sector Undertakings/autonomous bodies of Union and the State Governments.

Sir/Madam,

As you are aware, that holding of elective offices in various sports bodies by employees of Central Government is regulated in terms of the provisions contained in the Central Civil Services (Conduct Rules), 1964. In terms of Rule 15(1) of the CCS (Conduct) Rules, previous sanction of the Government or the prescribed authority is required to hold an elective office, in any body, whether incorporated or not. Further, instructions issued vide the Department of Personnel & Training's OM No.11013/3/9/03-Estt-(A) dated 22-04-1994 provide, inter-alia, that no Government servant should be allowed to hold elective office in any sports association/federation for a term of more than 4 years or for one term, whichever is less. These instructions were made part of the National Sports Development Code of India, effective from 31.01.2011. Vide letter No.14-82/2009-SP-IV dated 04-02-2010, the aforesaid provisions were made applicable to the employees of State/UT governments and all Chief Secretaries of States/UTs were informed.

2. The issue of holding elective post by the employees of Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs)/autonomous bodies of Union and State Governments has been considered in this Ministry and it has been decided that employees of PSUs/autonomous bodies of Union/State Governments will also be governed by the same principle as applicable to government servants.
